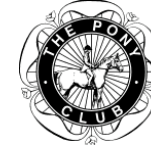

The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor, who in the opinion of the judges, is not capable of riding the course, or who uses bad language or abusive behaviour.

Entries close on July 20th and any entries received after that date will be subject to a £5 surcharge and may be placed on a waiting list.

Horses that are graded British Eventing Advanced (Grade 1) and have completed at OI/AI/A level during the current calendar year are not eligible.

All other horses are eligible.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing rules 2009, modified where applicable.
 2. The decision of the Judges and Organisers is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse any entry without stating a reason.
 3. In the event of cancellation, the entry fees, less £7 per person will be refunded on receipt of an S.A.E.
 4. It is regretted that entry fees can only be refunded after the closing date on production of a Medical or Veterinary Certificate. An administration fee of £7 will be retained.
 5. There will be a £5 levy for any substitution of horse, rider or combination made after the closing date.
 6. **LEGAL LIABILITY.** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event, nor The Pony Club, or any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars/vehicles, their contents and accessories any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any way whatsoever.
 7. **HEALTH AND SAFETY.** The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the rules and instructions of the organisers and stewards/officials.
 8. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times **and also for dismounted prizegiving.**
 9. Body protectors are recommended for Show Jumping and are compulsory for the cross country.
 10. A protective helmet meeting current Pony Club standards must be worn. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged. Tags can be fitted in the Secretary's tent.
 11. All horses must be aged 5 and over
 12. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organiser within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £10, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
 13. In the interests of safety, dogs **MUST** be kept on leads at all times and **NO STALLIONS** except by prior permission.
 14. Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before the start time for each phase.
 15. **STARTING TIMES** may be obtained by ringing 01643862589 between 19.00 and 21.00 hours on Friday 23rd July only. Times will also be posted on the Internet on: www.branches.pcuk.org/devon/
 16. **COURSE INSPECTION.** The cross-country course will be open for inspection from 1400 on Monday July 26th.
 17. **STOP WATCHES** may not be used during the cross-country phase.
 18. **MEDICAL ARMBANDS** must be worn during the cross-country phase.
 19. Competitors wearing body cages **MUST** leave the key with the Secretary before they go cross country.
 20. BE Style number bibs must be provided by competitors
