The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to safeguard the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, competitors and spectators are required to take due care at all times and to obey any notices or requests made by official stewards in the interests of their own and others safety.

**Hats to current British Safety Standards must be worn and securely fastened when mounted. Dress code in accordance with BRC / PC rules.**

**The judge's decision is final. Objections must be made to the Secretary's Office within 15 minutes of the results or incident with a £10 deposit. The deposit will be reimbursed if the objection is upheld.**

Please keep dogs on a lead at all times, including around the parking area.

Please remove litter and droppings from the parking area.

Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside lorry/trailer and left unattended or tied up to any fencing.

No lunging allowed in warm up area.

The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule or advertised start time, refuse any entry and cancel any class or competition.

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old and over.

No horse can be entered twice in one class.

## **Directions**

### **From M5 Taunton, Junction 25**

Follow A358 signposted to Minehead for about 10 miles. Just after Cedar Falls Health Resort, turn left onto B3224 and continue for another 10 miles. Turn right 1/2 mile after Raleighs Cross Pub on to B3224 sign posted to Wheddon Cross, the Cross Country Course is 3 miles along this road, on the right hand side.

### **From Tiverton**

Take A396 signposted to Bampton, then B3227 to Bampton. Continue through Bampton and turn onto the B3190 to Morebath. Continue through Morebath and Upton and along this road until you reach a chapel on your left hand side where there is a sharp turning left onto the B3224. The Cross Country Course is 3 miles along this road, on the right hand side.

## SHOW JUMPING RULES

See also General Rules

1. Hats with a CE mark and a quality symbol, either the BSI Kitemark, the SAI Global symbol or the official snell label with number must be worn at all times when mounted. A competitor whose hat comes off must, on penalty of elimination replace it before continuing
2. BODY PROTECTORS ARE ADVISED
3. Entries on the field will be accepted
4. The organisers reserve the right to close entries when they consider classes full
5. Excessive use of the whip will lead to disqualification
6. In the event of cancellation, up to 25% of the entry money may be retained

**\*Western Somerset Region Dressage Championships (WSRDC):** the two top placed eligible competitors will qualify for WSRDC.

**Eligibility:**

1. WSRDC is only open to members of the following Area 12 Riding Clubs: Witheridge, Taunton & District, West Somerset, Exeter, Quantock, Sid & Otter Valley, North Devon or Blackdown Hills.
2. Horses or ponies in the Prelim class must have no BD points, and those in the Novice class no more than 49 BD points at the time of the qualification.
